One Great Hour of Sharing

More than sixty years ago, in response to the devastation of World War II, a Saturday evening broadcast asked Americans to give generously the next morning in their churches. A remarkable variety of national leaders and celebrities gave their efforts to the broadcast. More than seventy-five thousand churches responded. So was born "The One Great Hour of Sharing".

Today our Presbyterian Church USA uses it's offering gifts roughly divided into thirds. Each of these three programs-self development of people, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance and the Presbyterian Hunger program- receives 32% of the offering. The remaining 4 % goes to the Presbyterian program for its work on homelessness and affordable housing.

The Presbyterian Church USA offering has received eight to eleven million dollars a year for at least the past 20 years.
